

# Friendship Focus September 2025

After this the Lord appointed seventy others and sent them on ahead of him in pairs to every town and place where he himself intended to go. He said to them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore ask the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest."

Luke 10: 1-2

Grace to you and peace from our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Amen.

In my Lutheran Study Bible this section of Luke's gospel is entitled, "The Mission of the Seventy." This section of scripture comes at a time in the gospel narrative when so many are clinging to Jesus' words; so many want to follow their rabbi, Jesus. Jesus' words, the message he has shared, his miraculous healings and feedings and his modeling of God's love all have drawn the Jewish people to him. They believe Jesus is the promised Messiah and so they want to learn from him; they want to follow him.

Seeing how God has blessed their time together, Jesus sent his followers out into the world on a mission to share the good news they had heard and experienced. He sent them in pairs to every town because he knew that there was much mission work to be done. People from all over had not heard the good news that a Savior had come and that their God was Lord of grace and love and forgiveness. God is Lord of redemption; and he had sent his only Son Jesus to save his people.

Recently in a sermon we've heard God's word asking us what it means for us to be "Friendship Lutheran Church." What does it mean to be a good and faithful friend? How is God calling us to live into our identity? We discovered how friendship in the Lord is deeper, more intentional, than simply being friendly. Anyone can be friendly. But to be faithful in our friendship calls us to a more meaningful, sacrificial way of discipleship living that involves worship, fellowship and service all together as a friendship community – always welcoming new friends to come and experience the friendship God creates in the community of Christ.

These verses from Luke's gospel exemplify our mission work here and now to be faithful friends to our God, our church family and to the world. The pages of this monthly newsletter are filled with opportunities and events we feel called to participate in and lead in this friendship response to what we believe is God's mission for us here and now. As you read the pages of this newsletter and consider all the wonderful work God is doing in and through us, take time to discern your place in it. For God is calling us to grow in our identity as Friendship.

It is evident that the Spirit is alive in this place, working through us to do God's important work with our very hands. I am convinced that Jesus has called us to mission, too. He is calling us and he is sending us out just like he did his first disciples. He is sending us out to be good friends, modeling his love to all people so that all may come to know Jesus as Lord! I pray that with each and every mission project or ministry we participate in and lead, we remember the mission that God has called us to through Jesus Christ, to be his disciples and to share the very good news that Jesus is Lord and his love for us never fails! Go forth this month knowing you have been called by God to be his very hands and feet as you minister to his people and serve him in mission!

President Doug Ramsey called the meeting to order.

Motion by Michelle Miller; seconded by Tamara Stafford to approve the agenda with the addition of New Business: a) Homecoming Pastor; b) Columbarium. Motion carries.

Michelle Miller shared a devotion.

Motion by Wade Cline; seconded by Angie Mooney to approve minutes from May 20, 2025 regular meeting, June 2, 2025 special informational meeting; and electronic vote on June 16, 2025. Motion carries.

Treasurers report was distributed. Motion by Nikki Icard; seconded by Monica Stafford to approve. Motion carries.

<u>Administration</u> – Hannah Bostian – No report.

<u>Worship</u> – Chris Jolly – Pastor Josh reported the laptop that was donated is up and working.

<u>Share</u> – Chris Bowman – TV for entrance space in the fellowship hall has been installed and is running signage each week. The team is waiting on a couple more items for the welcome bags and then they will be put together and ready.
