We Wait. Advent is the time of year when we wait for the anticipated arrival of the birth of Jesus, the Messiah. We wait for his coming into this world and we wait for the true message of hope and peace that he brings to us. Most of all, we wait in long and expected hope of the salvation that can only be found through his life, death and resurrection.

We wait for the babe in a manger but we also wait with sureness and certainty Christ will come again. Just as he promised, Jesus went on from this world to prepare a place for us, and just as he promised he will come again for us so that we may all be united in the kingdom of God as one. Advent is about this kind of waiting, too: waiting for Christ to come again.

Waiting can be exciting at times, as we live our lives full of anticipation. We continue on our faith walk as disciples of Christ during this time focused on what God is calling us to do to make himself known in the world. Waiting, then, can be about spending precious time with family and friends, decorating, caroling and glorifying God through worship and service during this holiday season.

But, sometimes waiting is not easy. The seasons of Advent and Christmas can bring about sadness as we remember past times spent with loved ones who are no longer with us. It's also easy for us to lose the focus and meaning of the holiday season with all of the attention on shopping, gift giving and the secularized meanings of Christmas.

No matter where we find ourselves in this season of waiting, we cling to the words from Luke with the annunciation of Jesus' birth. In the first chapter, the birth narrative begins as the angel Gabriel visits the virgin, Mary. The text tells us of Mary's confusion and anxiety over the presence of the angel with her and in his words, "Greeting, favored one." How could a lowly virgin have found favor with God? The angel continues to assure Mary saying, "the Lord is with you."

This advent and Christmas season let us never forget that we too have found favor with God and that God is with us. We are his chosen people; his people who are called to do great things. And, he is with us every step of the way as we do these things and as we wait for him this season. The Lord is with us! Even as we get caught up in the busy-ness of the season or as we remember great times with loved ones in the past, the Lord is with us and he has favored us. Let us wait with anticipation and hope as Jesus comes!

I wish you and your family a blessed Advent and Christmas. I pray that you may see the presence of Christ with you as you spend time with your families, your friends and with you church family. I pray that as we wait together for the coming of Christ, may we not lose sight of the miracle that happened so long ago in a manger in Bethlehem, and that we may not lose sight of the miracle that is still happening today as we answer the call to be Christ's disciples, carrying out his work in the world so that all my know of his love. God bless you in this season of waiting.

President Mary Ann Icenhour called the meeting to order, and Tyler Hall shared a devotion.

Motion by Marty Buff; seconded by Monica Stafford to approve the minutes from the regular meeting on September 13, 2022. Motion carries.

Treasurer's report for the month was distributed.

TEAM REPORTS:

Administration – Sandra Icenhour – No report.

Care – Wade Cline – 50 units were received at the blood drive. Planning to serve 500 at Trunk-R-Treat with help from Reformation and St Luke.

Learn – John Bostian – The team continues to work on a flyer that can be picked up as you enter worship each Sunday that will help visitors know we offer other than worship service. This will detail what is being discussed in each class as well as where classes are located. Also, to include activities going on during the week for different age groups.

Worship -Monica Stafford - Upcoming events include Pastor Josh's installation - October 23; All Saints Sunday – Nov. 6; Veterans Sunday with a video and refreshments – Nov. 13; Thanksgiving service – Nov. 23 at 7 pm with canned food offering; Christmas Eve services at 5 pm and 9 pm. Christmas Day and New Year's Day will be one service Sundays and no Sunday School. Pastor Josh will be on vacation on January 1. 5th Sunday rotation is being discussed. Communion at the rail at 10:30 will resume by bringing your individual wine/wafer set with you as you come up. Pastor Josh will implement a "Noisy Offering" for the kids to begin in November.

Motion by Mary Buff; seconded by Jimmy Watts to feed the ACHS Football team on October 28. John and Hannah Bostian will handle the details. Motion carries. Pastor Josh would like to be involved with this.

Jimmy Watts will follow up with getting the swing sets that were purchased in the past, set up on the playground.

There being no other business, the meeting adjourned with prayer.

Our next regular monthly meeting will be at 7 pm on Tuesday, November 8, 2022. Jimmy Watts is scheduled to share a devotion.
